Sasha Mills is Director of Cross Cutting Policy. She is a member of the Prudential Regulatory Authority's (PRA) Supervision, Risk and Policy Committee, Financial Markets Infrastructure Executive Committee and ExCo. She is the UK alternate member of the Board of Supervisors and Management Board of the European Banking Authority.

Sasha is responsible for a number of key policy areas, including the PRA's implementation of banking and insurance structural policy; groups; remuneration; governance, systems and controls; disclosure and reporting; and accounting policy. Her areas of responsibility also cover policy research; economic impact analysis; macroprudential toolkit development; international banking and insurance coordination; Financial Policy Committee priorities on ending Too Big to Fail and the banking capital framework; and development of the PRA's medium term regulatory strategy.

Having worked in central banking and supervision for over 25 years, Sasha's experience includes risk management, establishing the supervisory quality assurance function, financial stability, major UK bank supervision, and government bond operations. Previously, she was Head of Banking Supervision and Prudential Support, providing policy, technical and analytical support for supervision, policy, the PRA Board and Financial Policy Committee.
