

Decision of the Executive Director on the 2016 Public Holidays Schedule

The Executive Director

Having regard to the Staff Regulations of Officials of the European Communities and the Conditions of Employment of Other Servants of the European Communities laid down by Council Regulation (EEC, Euratom, ECSC) No 259/68¹,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EU) n° 1093/2010 of 24 November 2010 setting up a European Banking Authority,

Having regard to the Commission Decision of 16 February 2015 on the list of public holidays for 2016 for the institutions of the European Union No 08-2015,

Has adopted this decision:

Article 1 – Public holidays

The public holidays in 2016 for the EBA shall be as follows:

1 January	Friday, New Year's Day
24 March	Maundy Thursday/Holy Thursday
25 March	Good Friday
28 March	Easter Monday
29 April	Orthodox Good Friday
5 May	Thursday, Ascension Day
6 May	Friday after Ascension Day
9 May	Monday, Anniversary of the Declaration by President Schuman
16 May	Whit Monday
6 June	Monday, Spring Bank Holiday
29 August	Monday, Summer Bank Holiday
1 November	Tuesday, All Saints' Day
26 December to 30 December	Monday Friday (five end-of-year days)

Without prejudice to the schedule of public holidays for 2017, Monday 2 January 2017 will be a holiday.

The EBA reserves the right to modify these provisions, should the needs of the service so require.
