NOTIFICATION ON UNAVAILABILITY OF DEPOSITS AT BANK:

- BANKA SPLITSKO-DALMATINSKA D.D., SPLIT, CROATIA

Croatian State Agency for Deposit Insurance and Bank Resolution guarantees the protection of the funds of depositors of credit institutions and thereby increases the reliability and stability of the financial sector.

Croatian National Bank (Supervision Authority <https://www.hnb.hr/-/hnb-predlozio-otvaranje-stecajnog-postupka-nad-bankom-splitsko-dalmatinskom-d-d-split>) as of 25th May 2016 the decided to withdraw the license of the bank Banka splitsko-dalmatinska d.d., Split, Croatia – (date of determination of the unavailability of deposits) and appointed its temporary administrator.

The direct reason for the determination of unavailability of deposits was the fact that assets of this bank were not sufficient to meet its obligations.

The credit institution possessed 8212 depositors with the deposits compensation to EUR 50,74 million.

According to the size of the property it was the 31st (out of 33) credit institutions in Croatia.

The deposits reimbursement started on June 10th, 2016 (10th working day). The bank agent (Hrvatska poštanska banka p.l.c., Zagreb, Croatia) reimburses deposits to the depositors.

The Agency continues the reimbursement process until June 9th, 2019.
