Mary-Elizabeth McMunn has been Director of Credit Institutions Supervision at the Central Bank of Ireland since July 2018. The Director of Credit Institutions Supervision is responsible for the overall delivery of robust authorisation and prudential supervision of credit institutions established in Ireland (with the exception of investment banks), including Credit Unions. This includes working as part of the Single Supervisory Mechanism.

Ms McMunn joined the Central Bank of Ireland in 1997. Prior to her appointment as Director of Credit Institutions Supervision, she held roles as Head of Supervisory Risk Division and Deputy Head of both Banking Supervision and Insurance Supervision Divisions at the Central Bank of Ireland. Ms McMunn has also worked as a Manager in KPMG Regulatory Advisory Services for two years.

Ms McMunn holds an M.Sc in Investment & Treasury from Dublin City University, is a graduate of the Smurfit Business School, and holds a B.A. in Economics from University College Dublin.
