He earned his degree in administration management in 2003 at Public Administration College, then in law at University of Pécs in 2007, then economics at Szent István University of Budapest in 2014.

Employment:

He started his professional career as a financial expert for Hungarian Ministry of Finance in 2003, then joined Budapest V. District local government in 2009 as Head of the Financial Unit. In 2012 he was appointed Deputy Head of Department of the Hungarian State Treasury at the Ministry for National Economy and later in that year he became the President of the Hungarian Treasury. In 2013 he was appointed as Member of the Monetary Council, then he became the Chairman and CEO of MARK Ltd., which is an asset management company established by the Hungarian Central Bank. Currently he is the Executive Director of the Magyar Nemzeti Bank responsible for the supervision of financial institutions.

Public functions:

While holding the position of President of the Hungarian Treasury, he served as member of the Supervisory Board of the Hungarian Central Bank. 2013-14 he was member of the Board of Directors of GIRO Ltd, the automated clearing house operator in Hungary. From 2013 he sits on the Supervisory Board of the Banknote Printing Company owned by the Hungarian Central Bank.
