### DORA JOINT OVERSIGHT VENTURE

#### **CANDIDATES ARE REQUESTED TO INDICATE THEIR CHOSEN PROFILES OF EXPERTISE IN THE ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA GRID**

In response to the mandate given to them by the Digital Operational Resilience Act (DORA) for the oversight of critical third-party providers (CTPPs) of information and technology (ICT) services to financial entities in Europe, the three European Supervisory Authorities (ESAs) have decided to pool their resources and carry out their activities jointly in a Joint Oversight Venture (JOV). While their teams remain embedded in each ESA, they work as “one team”, headed by a “DORA Joint Oversight Director”.

The oversight of CTPPs is meant to ensure that these providers have comprehensive, sound and effective rules, procedures, mechanisms and arrangements in place to manage the ICT and concentration risks they pose to FEs and to ensure the safeguarding of financial stability. Oversight activities include designation of CTPPs, general investigations and onsite inspections, issuance of recommendations and follow-up.

The selected candidate(s) will be working on the data analysis related to the designation of CTPPs, namely on:

- Prepare and support the cleansing and enhancement of the data from the FEs’ registers of information, for the purpose of the CTPP designation;
- Prepare and support the entity resolution and grouping of third-party providers.
- Prepare and support the assessment of criticality of third-party providers in accordance with regulatory criteria.
- Provision of business support in the development of the IT tools used for oversight activities, in particular for CTPP designation.

A typical candidate has experience in the aforementioned areas, strong knowledge and skills in data analysis, and capacity to work on other oversight-related tasks.
