

LOSS ABSORPTION CAPACITY - MREL & TLAC

This course helps staff of resolution authorities in setting and enforcing MREL and resolution planning. Participants will understand loss absorption, recapitalization, and apply methodologies for MREL requirements. The content is updated for the new banking package (CRR2/BRRD2). The course takes 8 hours to complete. Participants should know high-level supervisory concepts (e.g., RWA, LRE, pillar 1/2, SREP) and reasons for bank failures (e.g., insolvency, asset impairment, illiquidity). By the end of the course, participants will understand loss absorption and recapitalization principles and apply the EU regulatory framework.

SUPERVISORY REPORTING - FINREP & COREP - 2024 Update

The Supervisory Reporting course for credit institutions covers the CRD/CRR framework requirements defined by the EBA. It provides an overview of COREP (solvency reporting) and FINREP (financial reporting) modules, helping participants understand data sources for supervisory questions, compare bank indicators, and calculate risk indicators. The course includes updated e-learning modules reflecting v4.0 changes effective from Q1 2025 and instructor-led sessions. The 2024 update incorporates amendments from CRR3/CRD6, focusing on COREP changes for the output floor, operational risk framework, and crypto asset exposures, excluding Market Risk updates. The course aims to familiarize participants with the latest supervisory reporting requirements in the EU.
