## Monika Marcinkowska



**Professor Monika Marcinkowska** is the head of the Banking Department and the Institute of Finance at the Faculty of Economics and Sociology of the University of Łódź, Poland. Monika holds PhD in management, habilitation degree in economics and is a full professor of finance and banking. In past she has worked for several banks and now is an independent member of supervisory boards of two financial institutions.

She coordinated several research project concerning corporate governance, bank value measurement and management, financial exclusion, impact of banking regulation on growth etc. Monika is the author of several books (inter alia: *Corporate governance in banks – theory and practice*; *Banks' relationship capital*; *Capital standards for banks*) and articles on banking regulations, financial stability, corporate governance in banks, value management and corporate social responsibility.

She is a member of the editorial board of four scientific journals and is an independent reviewer for research organisations and scientific journals. She is a member of the Committee of Finance Science of the Polish Academy of Science.

She was elected to the European Banking Authority's Banking Stakeholder Group with effect of April, 2016 (BSG III) an reelected to BSG IV (2018) and BSG V (2020).
