I acknowledge receipt of your letter of 1 March 2018 (Ref. Ares(2018)1166411) requesting the EBA to make full use of its powers to ensure that the Latvian bank, *ABLV Bank*, satisfies the requirements laid down in the acts referred to in Article 1(2) of Regulation (EU) No 1093/2010 and to investigate a possible breach or non-application of Union law.

The EBA stands ready to review actions taken by the competent authorities into ABLV Bank, but notes that the main EBA tool for addressing potential infringements of Union law is breach of Union law investigations in respect of competent authorities rather than financial institutions.
