

David Rozumek – Executive Director, Financial Market Supervision Department, Czech National Bank

David Rozumek has worked in supervision since 1999. Initially he participated in inspection visits and enforcement administrative procedures as analyst; thereafter he was appointed head of the licensing section of the investment services providers division and shortly after he was promoted to head of the whole division. After the establishment of the single supervisory authority in 2006, David Rozumek joined the Czech National Bank as head of investment services providers' supervision department. After reorganization of supervision in Czech National Bank in 2008 he promoted to a position of the deputy executive director of the financial market supervision department. Since July 2008 he has been the executive director of the financial market supervision department.

David Rozumek was member of the CESR expert group on intermediaries. Since 2008 he was a member of CEBS for the Czech Republic and following the establishment of ESA's in January 2011 he has been a member of the Board of Supervisors of both EBA and EIOPA. He was also a member of the EBA Management Board (until June 2012) and a chairman of the EBA Standing Committee on Regulation and Policy (until November 2013). Since September 2012 David Rozumek has been a member of the EBA Mediation Panel. David Rozumek is deeply involved in international cooperation, as he regularly represents the Czech National Bank on international forums.

David Rozumek has a Ph.D. degree in economics from Masaryk University of Brno in the Czech Republic. He is still active in academic discussions, as he cooperates with major universities in the Czech Republic. He has published articles in the daily press and professional journals, including for example *Revue bancaire et financière*.
