Ms Ludmila Vojevoda has been working in the area of banking supervision since 1993. From 1993 to 1995, she had been an economist and regulations expert of the Credit Institutions Supervision Department of the Bank of Latvia; but 1995-2001 – Head of Banking Regulations and Analysis Division of the Credit Institutions Supervision Department of the Bank of Latvia. Main responsibilities: implementation of EU banking directives, drafting of prudential regulations and banking legislation, analysis of banking sector developments, introduction of IAS compliant financial reporting.

Since 2001, she has been working for the Financial and Capital Market Commission (FCMC) as Director of Regulations and Statistics Department and Member of the Board.
