

## **Elisa Ferreira, Banco de Portugal**

Elisa Ferreira is currently Vice-Governor of Banco de Portugal since September 2017, and Member of the Supervisory Board of the Single Supervisory Mechanism (SSM) – from June 2016.

She joined Banco de Portugal in 20 June 2016 as a Member of the Board.

Prior to that, Elisa was a Member of the European Parliament – elected in 2004, 2009 and 2014 (July 2004 – June 2016). In that quality, she was a Member of the Economic and Monetary Affairs Committee; coordinator (spokesperson) of the Socialists and Democrats Parliamentary Group for Economic and Financial Affairs (2004-2016); Member of the first and second Special Parliamentary Committees on Tax Rulings and Other Measures Similar in Nature or Effect – TAXE 1, TAXE 2 (2015-2016); Member of the Working Group on Financial Assistance to the Euro zone countries (2016); Member of the Special Committee on the policy challenges and budgetary resources for a sustainable European Union (2010-2011) and Member of the Special Committee on the Economic, Financial and Social crises (2009-2011).

She was also the Rapporteur (Coordinator) of the European Parliament's position on various legislative proposals related to the financial system as well as on several economic, budgetary and tax policy matters, inter alia: Co-Rapporteur of the TAXE 1 Committee (2014-2015); Rapporteur on the Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council establishing uniform rules and a uniform procedure for the resolution of credit institutions and certain investment firms in the framework of the Single Resolution Mechanism (SRM) and a Single Resolution Fund (SRF) (2014); Rapporteur on two regulations of the “Two Pack” and “Six Pack” legislative proposals – Common provisions for monitoring and assessing draft budgetary plans and ensuring the correction of excessive deficit of the Member States in the Euro Area (2011-2012); Rapporteur on cross-border banking crises (2012); Rapporteur of the Special Committee on the Economic, Financial and Social crises (2011); Rapporteur of the Special Committee on the Economic, Financial and Social crises (2009-2011) and “Shadow rapporteur” of the Bank Recovery and Resolution Directive – BRRD (2013).

Previously, Elisa was a Member of the Portuguese Parliament (2002-2004); Minister for Planning in the 14th Constitutional Government (1999-2002); Minister for the Environment in the 13th Constitutional Government (1995-1999).

She is also a Senior lecturer at the Faculty of Economics of the Porto University (since 1977)

Elisa holds a PhD and a Master's Degree in Economics from the University of Reading (1985 and 1981), and a Degree in Economics from Porto University (1977).
