Sébastien de Brouwer is Chief Policy Officer at the European Banking Federation (EBF). As Executive Director, he is member of the EBF Senior Leadership team.

In this role of Chief Policy Officer, he is supervising all the EBF activities on legislative & regulatory subjects (prudential policy and supervision, digital and retail banking, payments, financial markets, sustainable finance, International, Social, Legal, and Tax issues, AML/CFT and compliance, etc.) which concern banks at European level.

He was already member of the previous EBA Banking Stakeholders Group (BSG) from mid-May 2019 to June 30, 2020.



As part of his activities, Sébastien is also Board member of the European Payment Council (EPC), Member of the Advisory Committee of fTLD Registry Services, LLC and member of various Expert Groups at EU level. He is member of the Editorial team of the Revue de Droit Bancaire et Financier (Larcier).

Sébastien joined the EBF in 2006. Before joining the EBF, Sébastien was Head of European Affairs and Member of the Executive Committee with Febelfin, the Belgian Federation of the financial industry (including banks) and previously legal adviser. Prior to that Sébastien also worked in an International bank (Custodian) and an Insurance Company (management of important claims).
